1. Cookies on our website

This cookie policy (“**Cookie Policy**”) is intended to inform you how Peak3/we use “cookies” and similar technologies on our website located at <http://www.peak3.com> and their sub-domains (our “Website”) and to assist you in making informed decisions when using our Website. Please take a moment to read and understand this Cookie Policy.

This Cookie Policy should be read in conjunction with our Privacy Policy.

2. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that is sent to your computer's hard drive by a website. Each time you return to the same website, your browser retrieves and sends the relevant cookie(s) to the website's server.

3. Cookie Acceptance

By using our Website after accepting the Cookie Notice that appears when you first visit the Website, or by browsing our Website, after having been presented with this notice, you agree to the placement of cookies on your computer or device in accordance with the terms of this Cookie Policy.

You can, at any time, change or withdraw your consent to our use of non-essential cookies on our Cookie Notice.

4. What Cookies do we use on our Website and what do we do with them?

Essential cookies: We use cookies where they are essential for the operation of the Website, for example page navigation and access to secure areas of the Website. The Website cannot function properly without these cookies.

Preference cookies: We use cookies to allow the Website to uniquely identify your browsing session on our Website, which allows us to coordinate this information with data from our Website server as well as remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region that you are in.

Performance cookies: We use cookies for “analytics” purposes to improve the Website. These cookies allow us to calculate the aggregate number of people using the Website and which features of our Website are most popular.

Marketing cookies: We use cookies to record your visit to our site, the pages you have visited, the links you have followed and information about your browser, device and your IP address. We may use this information to show you ads and other marketing materials based on your interests.

5. How do I manage cookies in my browser?

The "Help" section on the menu bar of most internet browsers will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to make the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie and how to disable cookies altogether. Please note that certain features of the Website may no longer be available to you if you disable cookies.

6. How do we make changes to this Cookie Policy?

We may change our Cookie Policy from time to time. When we change our Cookie Policy, we will publish the updated notice on our Website. Please check this Cookie Policy regularly. Subject to applicable law, all changes will take effect as soon as we publish the new Cookie Policy, but where we have already collected information about you and/or where legally required to do so, we may take additional steps to

inform you of any material changes to our Cookie Policy and may request that you agree to these changes.
